



NASDAQ OMX proposed organization

In conjunction to the proposed combination between NASDAQ and OMX, a new organization has been defined for the proposed group. This organization reflects the experience and expertise that each company brings into the combination.

NASDAQ OMX Group will be governed by a balanced management team under the leadership of Robert Greifeld, who will serve as Chief Executive Officer, and Magnus Böcker, serving as President.

Reflecting the customer groups, the proposed Business Areas are:

- **Financial Products** will provide the services that NASDAQ currently offers around the development of new indices of its own and with other partners.
- **Market Data** will combine OMX and NASDAQ's significant information services businesses.
- **Transactions Services US** will encompass all exchange operations for US listed securities.
- **Transactions Services Nordics** will encompass all exchange operations for Nordic listed securities.
- **European Growth Markets** will be established to manage pan-European initiatives, the activities in Central Eastern Europe and the exchanges in the Baltic countries.
- **Corporate Client Group** will be dedicated to providing issuers with unmatched customer service, visibility and market intelligence in all markets.
- **Corporate Services** will offer advanced issuer services such as senior management insurance and IR support services.
- **Market Technology** will define the technology offerings and handle sales and account management to technology customers.

Technology will be provided from two units:

- **Software Development** will handle all application development for the business areas.
- **IT Operations** will manage all the infrastructure and application operations.
