Partial Amendment No. 1 to SR-NASDAQ-2010-074

The NASDAQ Stock Market LLC (“NASDAQ”) is filing this partial amendment to SR-NASDAQ-2010-074 to add Exhibit 3 as the roster of 100 pilot securities to which proposed Rule 4753(c) will apply, which is attached hereto, and to make the following related addition to the filing:

1. Add the following language to Item 9 on page 17 of the original proposal: “3. Roster of 100 pilot securities.”

EXHIBIT 3

NASDAQ selected the NASDAQ 100 Index as the initial 100 pilot securities to which proposed Rule 4753(c) will apply. The table below is the current roster of NASDAQ 100 Index securities. Should a security in the NASDAQ 100 Index be removed and replaced during the six month pilot, Rule 4753(c) would no longer apply to the removed security, but would rather apply to the replacement security included in the index.
